



A reminder of the task

- In your groups you were first allocated some votes to cast in an election based on your policy preferences and the current polling. Once the election had been conducted you were allocated a political party and its seats in the legislature, along with its policy positions. You were then expected to formulate the negotiating position of your party and participate in attempts to form a coalition government, with the resultant policy positions being implemented (to the delight or chagrin of the voting population).
- The percentages of the votes allocated to each group were as follows:
 - Voting group 1: 4%
 - Voting group 2: 9%
 - Voting group 3: 6%
 - Voting group 4: 4%
 - Voting group 5: 3%




Class 08: final election results




Class 08: coalition formed








Class 10: final election results




Class 10: coalition formed






Class 11: coalition formed




Class 12: final election results
